Did You Know ...

- 342 million metric tons of waste to landfills and incinerators in 2014 in US.
- If reduced paper waste by 1%, it would save companies nearly \$1 billion.
- Company waste is 37% paper, 21% food/other organic materials, 17% plastic, 11% construction materials, and 8% metals.

- Use credible standards to report on progress toward their sustainability targets and the SDGs.








